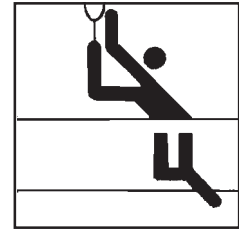


# Tennis

Dimensions for sport playing areas



Tennis is a racket game in which individuals (singles) or pairs (doubles) compete against each other. The game is played on a court divided by a net. The object of the game is to strike the ball over the net with the racket in such a way that it bounces in court and beats any attempt by an opponent to return it.

## Court Dimensions

Singles: 23.77m long x 8.23m wide.  
 Doubles: 23.77m long x 10.97m wide. All dimensions are to the outside edge of lines.

## Space about Court

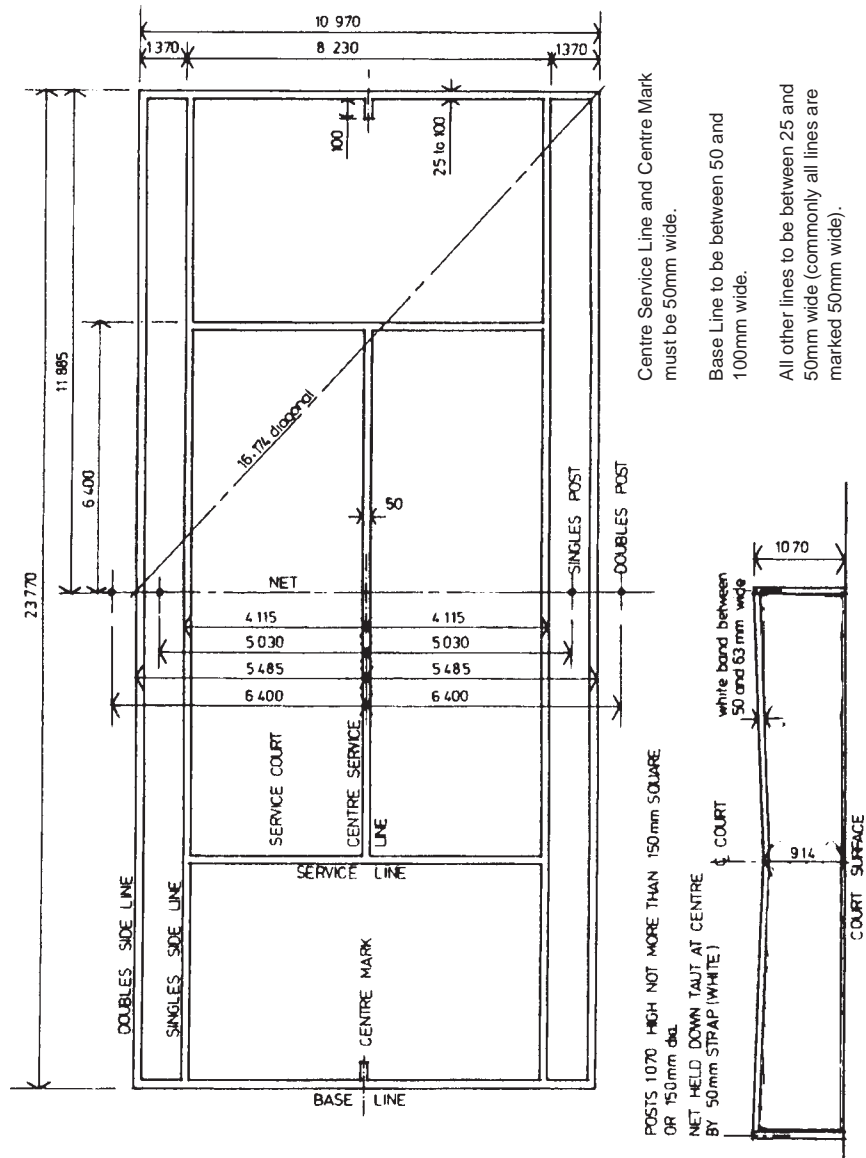
Davis Cup standard: 6.4m backrun and 3.66m from side fence. Playing area is 36.6m x 18.3m.

Club standard: 5.5m backrun and 3.05m from side fence. Playing area is 34.8m x 17.1m.

For two courts side by side, a clearance space of 3.66m is acceptable.

## Indoor Tennis

Height above net minimum 10.67m and at end of backrun minimum 4.27m.



Centre Service Line and Centre Mark must be 50mm wide.  
 Base Line to be between 50 and 100mm wide.  
 All other lines to be between 25 and 50mm wide (commonly all lines are marked 50mm wide).
