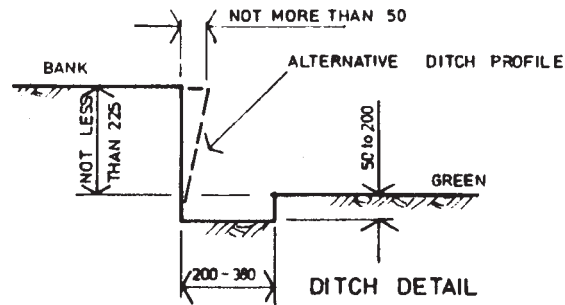
Indoor Bowls

Indoor bowls is played on a synthetic surface simulating lawn bowls.

Dimensions of Rink

The recommended size of rink is 34.75m x 4.57m, however the standard size is 32m x 4.27m.

Rinks are usually grouped in fours or sixes.

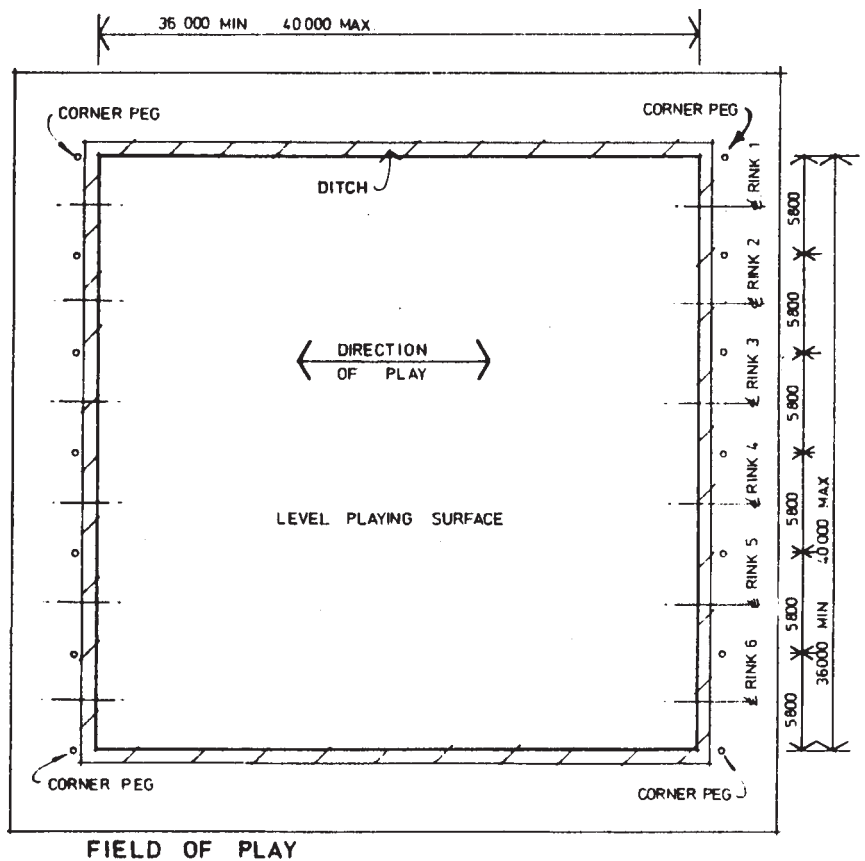


Lawn Bowls

Lawn bowls is a game played on a flat lawn or turf surrounded by a ditch and enclosed by a bank. Each player or team delivers a bowl towards a white smaller ball (known as the 'jack'). The object of each person or group is to position as many bowls as possible nearer to the jack than the nearest opposing bowls. Each bowl fulfilling that object scores a point.

A match may be person against person (singles), two against two (pairs), three against three (triples), or four against four (fours).

In contests it is customary for several individual matches to take place, usually simultaneously. Six rinks of fours is the most popular inter-group formula.



Dimensions of Green

Minimum 37m x 37m, Maximum 40m x 40m.

Rinks

The green is divided into rinks 5.8m wide (for club play, rinks may be a

minimum of 4.3m wide). Each rink is to have its centre line marked with a peg on the bank.

Mat

The mat is 600mm long x 360mm wide.
