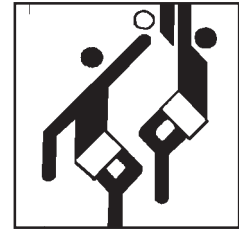


Netball



Dimensions for sport playing areas

Netball is a 7-a-side game. Points are scored by sending the ball through a ring at one's own end of the court.

By rule, netball is played on a firm surface. The game can be enjoyed as much indoors as outdoors.

Dimensions of Court

30.5m long x 15.25m wide. The longer sides shall be called Side Lines and the shorter sides Goal Lines

The court shall be divided into three equal parts – a Centre Third and two Goal Thirds – by two transverse lines drawn parallel to the Goal Lines.

A semi-circle with a radius of 4.9 metres and with its centre at the mid-point of the Goal Line shall be drawn in each Goal Third. This shall be called the Goal Circle.

A circle 0.9 metres in diameter shall mark the centre of the court. This shall be called the Centre Circle.

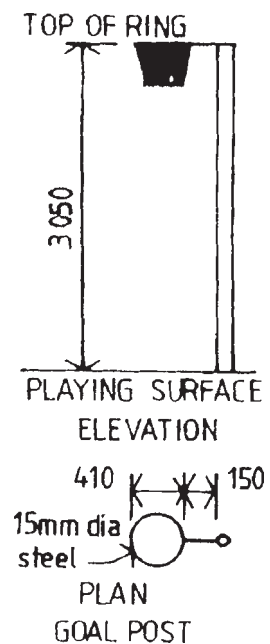
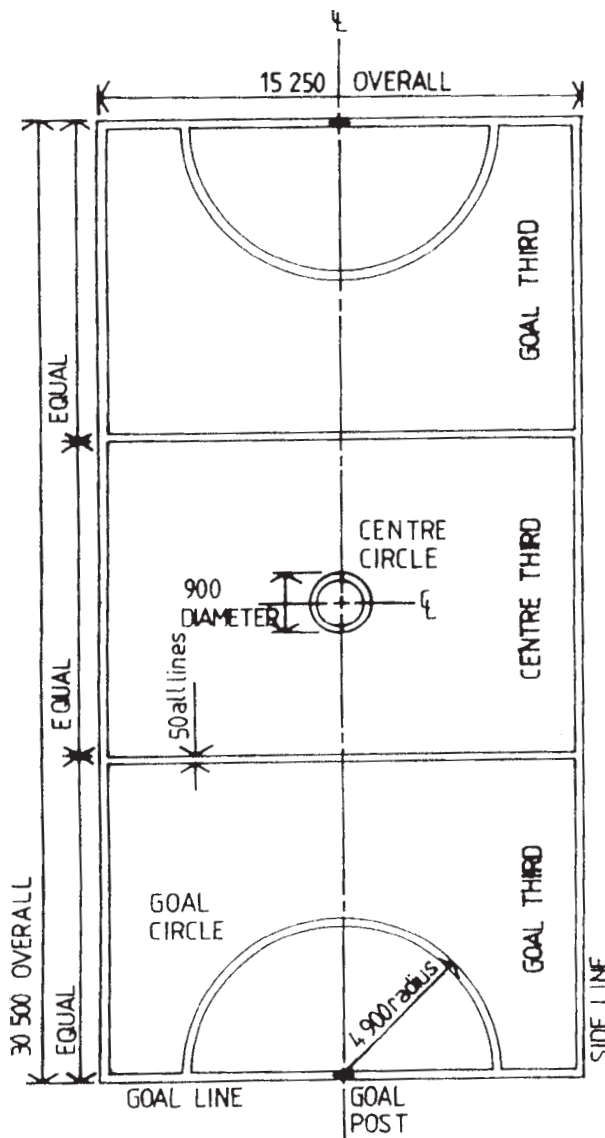
All lines are part of the court and shall not be more than 50mm wide.

Space about Court

Recommended minimum 3.7m all round. The court including free space requires an area 37.9m x 22.65m.

Goals

A goalpost which shall be vertical and 3.05 metres high shall be placed at the mid-point of each Goal Line. A metal ring with an internal diameter of 380mm shall project horizontally 150mm from the top of



the post, the attachment to allow 150mm between the post and the near side of the ring. The ring shall be of steel rod 15mm in diameter, fitted with a net clearly visible and open at both ends. Both ring and net are considered to be part of the goalpost. If padding is used on the goalpost, it shall not be more than

25mm thick and shall start at the base of the goalpost and extend between 2 metres and 2.4 metres up the goalpost.

Netta Netball (modified game - Under 9)

Court size as for adults. Goalpost height 2.4m. Players may use a smaller ball.
